

# Almeda Shields

Mrs. Almeda Shields, 71, of 211 Irving St., in charge of the newspaper scrapbook in the local history room in the Main Public Library, died today in Toledo Hospital.

Born in Columbus, and a resident of Toledo 40 years, Mrs. Shields was the widow of Alfred Shields, a Toledo attorney who died in 1930. She had been on the staff of the main library since 1935, and belonged to Trinity Episcopal Church, Fortnightly Book Club, Shakespeare Club and the Toledo Animal Shelter Association.

Surviving are a sister, Mrs. W. L. Hahn, Columbus, and a niece, Mrs. Marie Todd, Troy.
